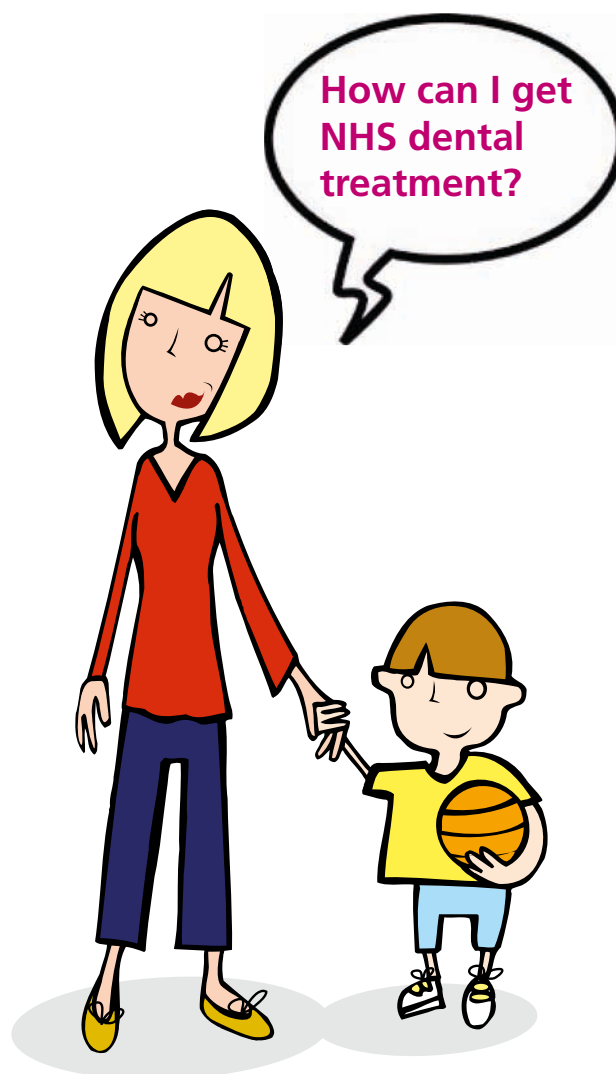


Services from your NHS dentist

If you do not qualify for free NHS dental treatment, the charge you pay for dental work depends on the treatment you need to keep your teeth, gums and mouth healthy. You should pay £16.50, £45.60 or £198.00 depending on the course of treatment that you need.



Free NHS dental treatment
